Descendants of John Terry (1713-1789) of Bucks County Pennsylvania

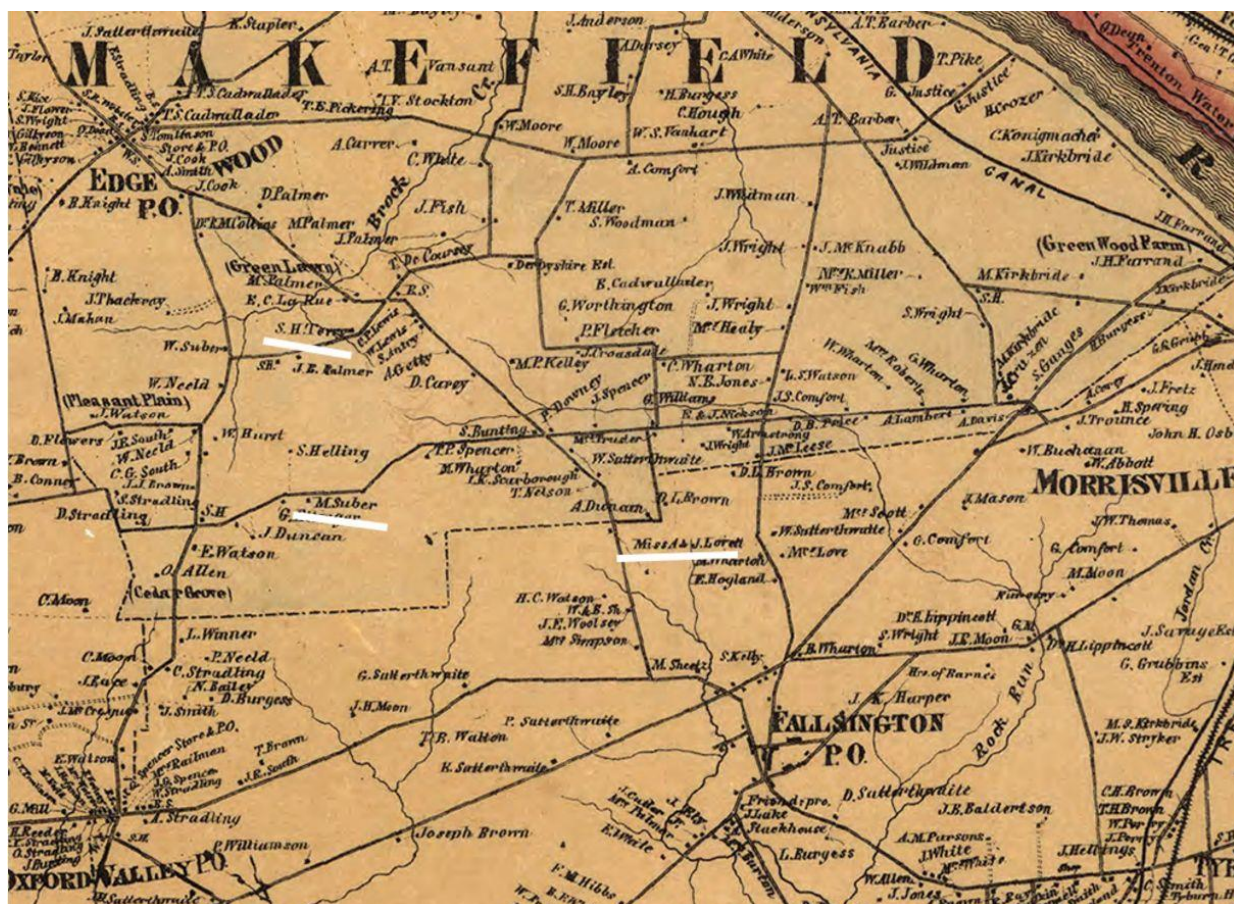


Figure 1. Makefield Township, Bucks County in 1861 showing the location of the Terry farm, the Subers farm and the Lovett farm.¹

This essay is a part (subdivision) of the 'Five Generations of the Terry of Bucks County Pennsylvania' essay, describing the descendants of John Terry, a grandson of Thomas Terry

(born abt 1653), the first Terry settler of Bucks County. John Terry (1713-1789) a grandson of Thomas has only one male descendant that had children and it is suspected that this son was adopted and carried the Terry name but not the Terry genes, carrying instead Lovett family genes.²

Conclusion: Patrick A. Terry does not have Terry Y-DNA (28 mismatches). Matches have generally genetic distances (column 1) of 2-4.

The fact that Patrick Terry, a living descendant of this John Terry, does not possess the Terry Y-DNA indicates that a non-paternity event (NPE) has occurred (commonly an adoption or illegitimacy). The NPE could have happened any time after abt 1653 (the birth of Thomas Terry of Bucks). This is because at least 3 of this Thomas Terry's progeny are proven to have virtually the same (Terry) Y-DNA (see 'Addendum 1. Analysis of Terry Y-DNA Markers'). Recently Patrick has been shown to be a blood descendant of the Lovett family (and to possess the Lovett Y-DNA).³ Lovett and Terry families were neighbors in the 16th and 17th century in England (Buckinghamshire) as well as in Bucks County (see Figure 1 and note 18 in the 'Five Gen's...' essay). This argues that the NPE is more likely to have happened in that century after the birth of Thomas Terry of Bucks before the families had moved further apart.

Examination of the genealogies of the two families during this period allows several observations to be made:

John Terry (b. 1713) married Rachel Heston Lacey, but they only had one daughter who died in infancy (1740) indicating they may have had biological problems raising a family.

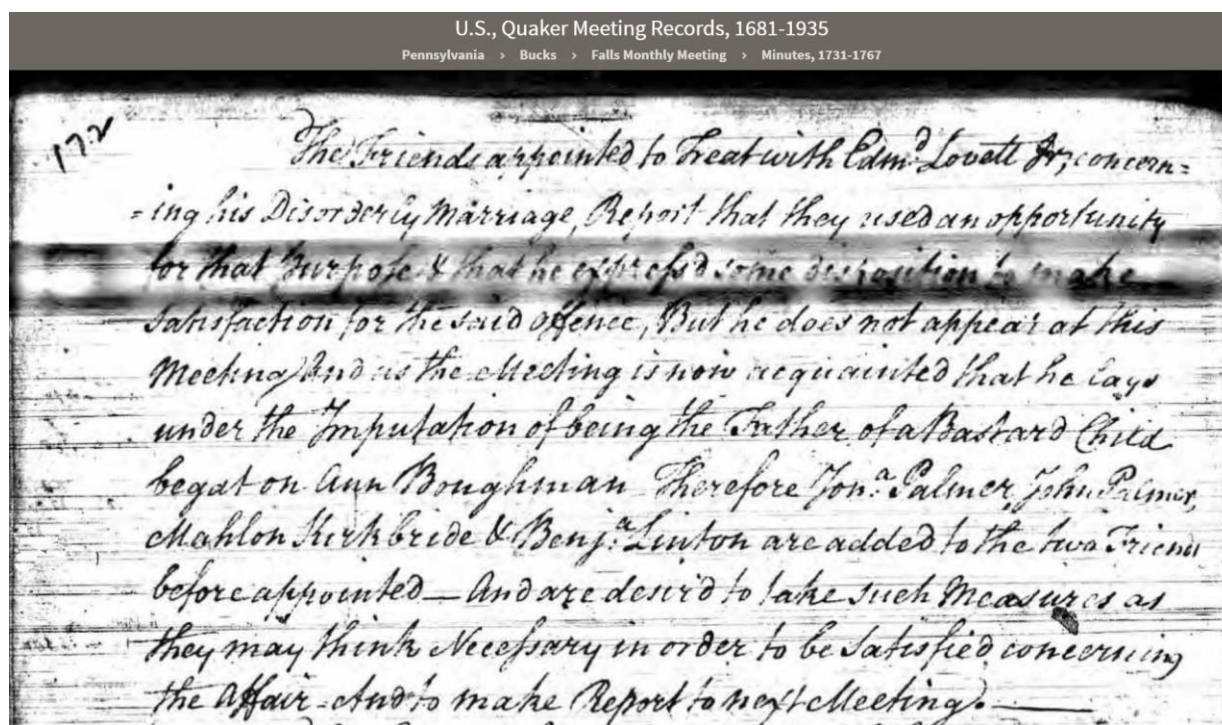


Figure 2. Illegitimate child of Edmund Lovett, Jr. with Ann Boughman, Falls Monthly Meeting, 6 Apr 1750 (Note 5).

In the Lovett family, Edmond Lovett, Jr. of Emilie, Middletown Township (now Bristol), Bucks (b. 1720, son of Edmund and Magdalena (Giffin/Gittin) Lovett) was 'removed'⁴ (disowned) in Sep 1750 by the Quakers (Falls Monthly Meeting, Bucks) for siring a bastard with Ann Boughman.⁵

His brother Daniel Lovett⁶ of Falls Township (1723-1785) was suspected (10 Jun 1762) of siring a bastard with his housekeeper.⁷ The bastard child of Daniel Lovett is described as 'a child' in 1762.⁸

It is most likely that it is the illegitimate child of Edmund Lovett, Jr. and Ann Boughman that was raised by the Terry neighbors (see Figure 2) as John Lacey Terry (b. 1740) since Daniel's bastard would probably have been too old to become 'John Lacey Terry'.

As speculative as this may seem, it is still the best and most probable explanation for the facts.

From the minutes: p.363 (1762) 'Three Friends appointed to meet with Daniel Lovett Report that most of them met at his House, and took an opportunity with him, but notwithstanding the advice of Friends, he still persists in keeping the Woman as a housekeeper. Whereupon this Meeting appoints Thomas Cornthwaite to acquaint him that if he will not take the advice of Friends and put the Woman away from his house, and take such other measure to clear his Character from the imputation of being the Father of the Child as shall be to the satisfaction of Friends, that the Meeting will be under the necessity of Testifying against him. To report to next meeting.'

1. **John Terry (Jasper² Thomas¹)^{10,11}** was born 1713 at Middletown, Bucks and died 1789¹² at Wrightstown, Bucks. He married¹³ (1) 31 Mar 1738 at Wrightstown, Bucks **Rachel Heston Lacey** daughter of John and Rachel (Heston) Lacey.¹⁴ She was born 2 Jan 1717 at Buckingham, Bucks and died 1750 at Wrightstown, Bucks. John married¹⁵ (2) abt 1750 **Sarah Walmsley** daughter of Thomas and Hannah (Walton) Walmsley. She was born 1729 at Southampton, Bucks. She married¹⁶ (2) 5 Dec 1798 at Wrightstown, Bucks **Benjamin Warner** of Muncy, Lycoming, Pennsylvania.¹⁷ John Terry was Bucks County Commissioner in 1758.¹⁸

John Terry made the move¹⁹ to Wrightstown from Middletown at the time of his marriage to Rachel in 1736 as the Terrys are not listed among the founding families of Wrightstown although the Hestons and Lacey are listed.²⁰

John and Rachel (Lacey) Terry had two children:²¹

- 2 i. **MARY LACEY TERRY**, born 11 Aug 1739 at Bucks and died 21 May 1740 at Wrightstown, Bucks.²²
- + 3 ii. **JOHN LACEY TERRY** (adopted **LOVETT**), born 24 Dec 1740 at Bucks and died 13 Nov 1829 at Wrightstown, Bucks. He married (1) **Sarah Ruth Davis** and (2) **Ruth Carver**.

John and Sarah (Walmsley) Terry had a son:

- 4 i. **JAMES WALMSLEY TERRY**, born 1752 of Bucks, Pennsylvania. There is no record of a James Terry in the Pennsylvania tax records or the 1790, 1800 or 1810 census of Pennsylvania. He may have died young.

Generation Four

3. John Lacey Terry (John³ Jasper² Thomas¹)²³ born 24 Dec 1740 (adopted Lovett) at Bucks and died 13 Nov 1829 at Wrightstown, Bucks. He was a cordwainer.²⁴ He married²⁵ (1) 22 Nov

1769 at Wrightstown, Bucks, **Sarah Ruth Davis**, daughter of Griffith²⁶ and Elizabeth (Coate) Davis of Solebury Twp., Bucks. She was born 1743 and died 7 Mar 1784 at Bucks, Pennsylvania.²⁷ He married²⁸ (2) 30 May 1792 at Wrightstown, Bucks **Ruth Carver** daughter of Joseph and Martha (Lowther) Carver.^{29,30} She was born 1755 at Buckingham, Bucks and died 23 Oct 1819 at Wrightstown, Bucks. She had a natural son Jacob.^{31,32}

John and Sarah (Davis) Terry had seven children:^{33,34}

+ 7 iii. **RACHEL TERRY**, born 1 Mar 1774 at Wrightstown, Bucks; died Aug 1857 at Wrightstown, Bucks. She married **Jacob Heston**.

He married abt 1795 **Sarah Stockdale**, daughter of Joseph and Elizabeth (Smith) Stockdale.^{35,36} She was born 20 Nov 1771 at Buckingham, Bucks and died 20 Nov 1854 at Baltimore, Baltimore, Maryland and was buried 22 Nov 1854 at Wrightstown, Bucks.^{37,38}

Charles and Sarah (Stockdale) Terry had three children.

15 i. **ELIZA TERRY** born abt 1796 of Moreland Twp, Montgomery, Pennsylvania and died Oct 1877, buried³⁹ in the Wrightstown Friends Meeting Cemetery.

16 ii. **WILLIAM TERRY**, born abt 1798 of Moreland Twp, Montgomery, Pennsylvania and died⁴⁰ 10 Aug 1820 as a result of a kick from a horse.

17 iii. **JOHN STOCKDALE TERRY**, born abt 1800 of Moreland Twp, Montgomery, Pennsylvania. He married⁴¹ 16 Nov 1825 **Martha/Mary Mullin Kirk** of Horsham Twp.⁴² (10 children: boys—Frederick M., Jacob, Charles, George W. and Rebecca Templeton,)

7. Rachel Terry (John Lacey⁴ John³ Jasper² Thomas¹) born 1770 at Wrightstown, Bucks; died 1857 at Wrightstown, Bucks. She married⁴³ 22 Apr 1795 at Wrightstown, Bucks **Jacob Heston** son of Jesse.

Jacob and Rachel (Terry) Heston had nine children.⁴⁴
